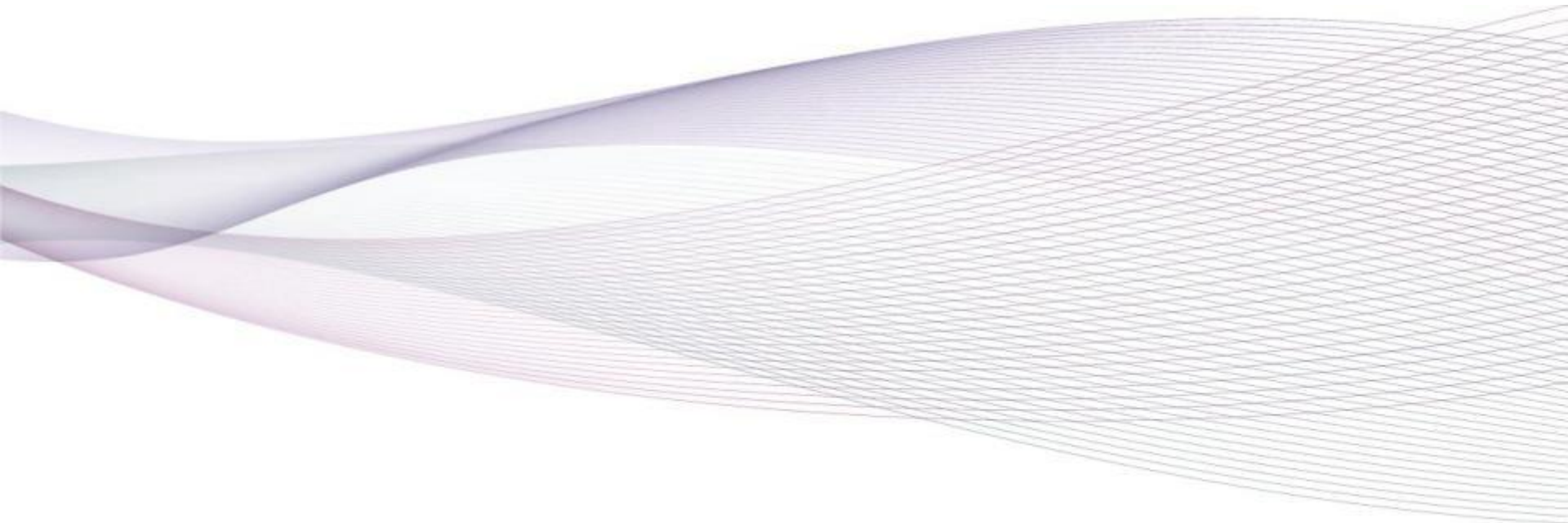

Dentures in one or both jaws.

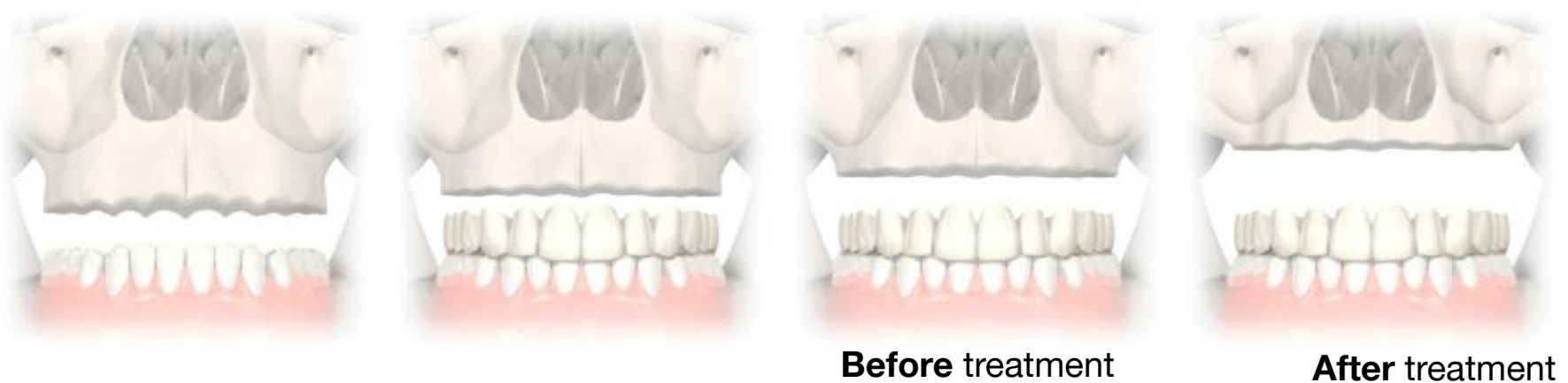
Approximately 30% of denture wearers experience problems with their dentures.

What might be the consequences of edentulism? (I)

- Jaws are getting thinner and narrower



- Jaws are getting thinner and narrower
- Facial changes
- Difficulty speaking, chewing and laughing
- Poorly fitting dentures may lead to sore spots or painful blisters



Scientific survey on complaints from people wearing dentures.

- Sense of premature aging
- Less self-confidence
- Social networking feels more difficult
- Embarrassment
- Less enjoyment of food and drinks
- No longer laughing freely

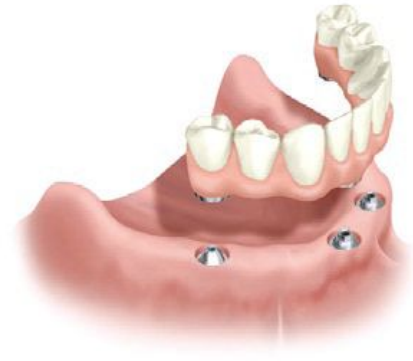
All Missing Teeth



Removable full denture

Fixed bridge on implants

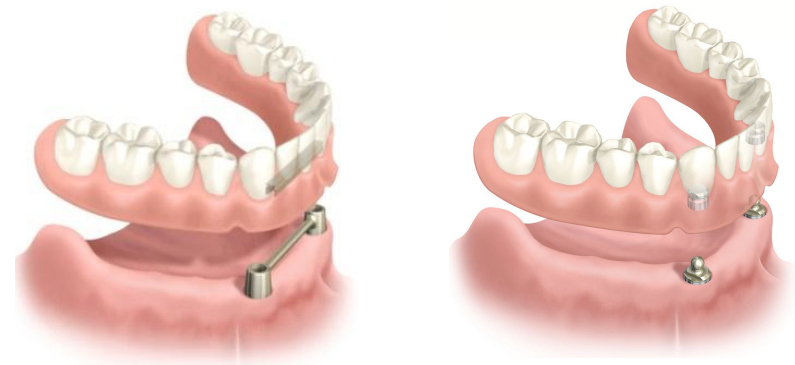
The difference:

Conventional dentures:



- Restores 10% of the chewing function.
- Provides support for the lip / cheek.
- May accelerate the shrinkage of the jaw.
- May have chronic problems due to bad fit .
- Sometimes causes long term pain and/or acute pain.
- Sometimes a need for denture relining.
- Add on adhesives for comfort.

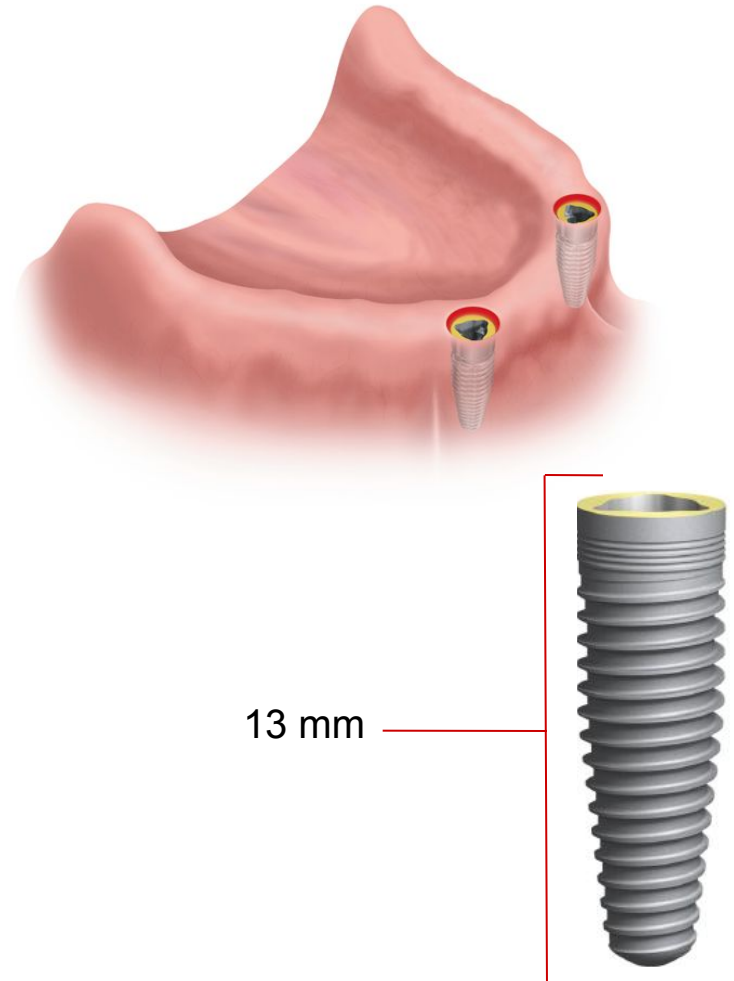
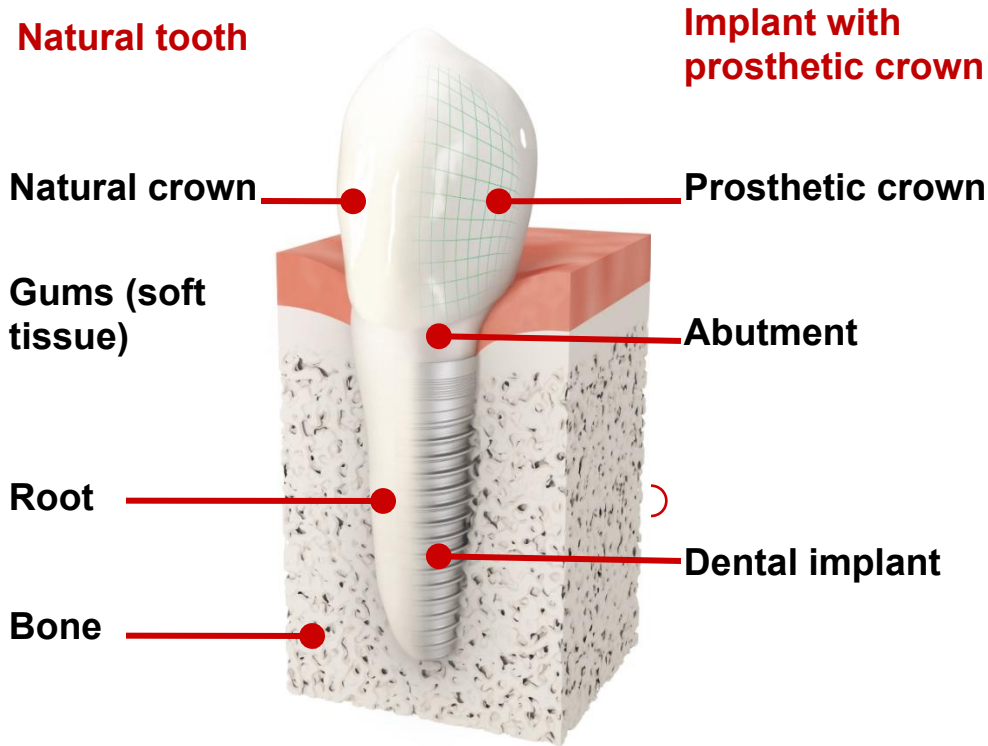
Dental implants and prosthesis:



- Restores 60–80% of the chewing function.
- Provides better support for the lip / cheek.
- Prevent further shrinkage of the jaw.
- Pain free when restoration is in place.
- Reduced or no need for denture relining.
- No extra fixation needed.

What is an implant?

A dental implant mimics a root of a tooth.



Advantages of dental implants.

- Look, feel and work like natural teeth.
- Preserves facial structure.
- Allows you to eat what you want, not what you have to.
- Long-term solution.
- Improved quality of life.
- Proven results.

A fixed bridge on multiple implants



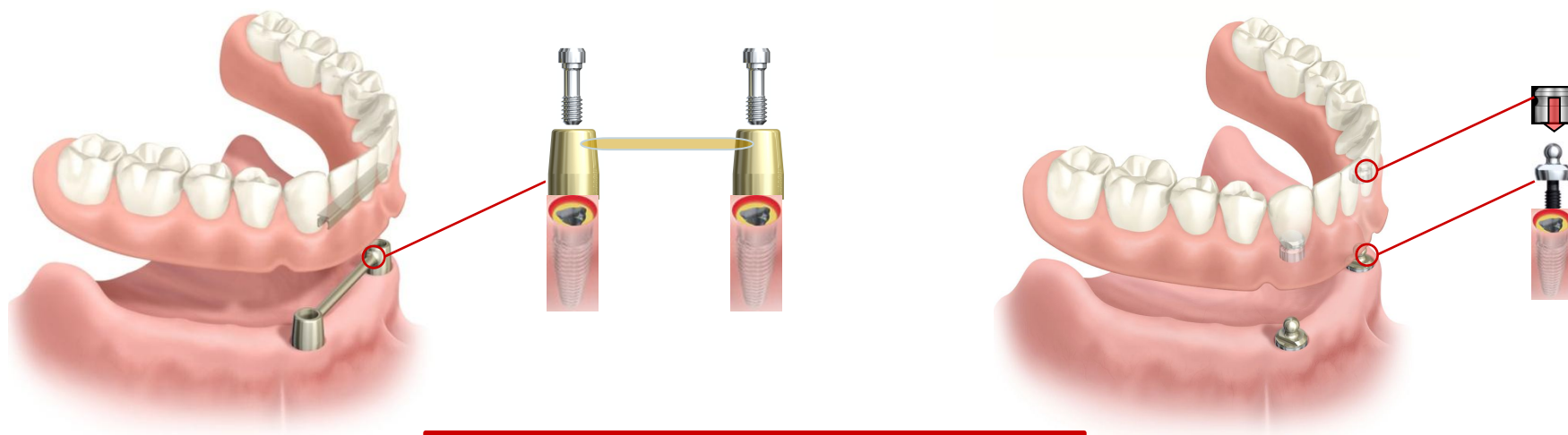
A removable bridge on a fixed implant bar

All-on-4 solution*

What is a fixed-removable solution?

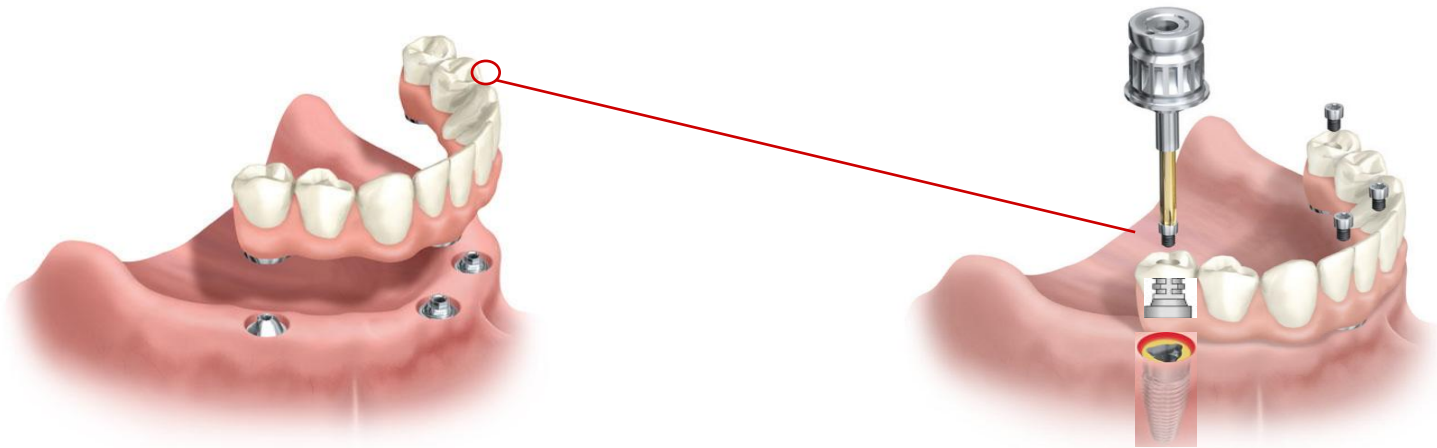
- Firm connection
- You can remove the prosthesis
- Implants and prosthesis are easy to clean, so is the bar.
- Treatment is almost always possible

What is a fixed solution?

- Feels like your own teeth
- The prosthesis is fixed to the implants and does not have to be removed
- Cleaning needs some practice
- Treatment is possible in most cases

Removable full-arch solutions



Removable full-arch solutions secured on two-or more implants

A removable full arch solution is anchored to two or more implants.

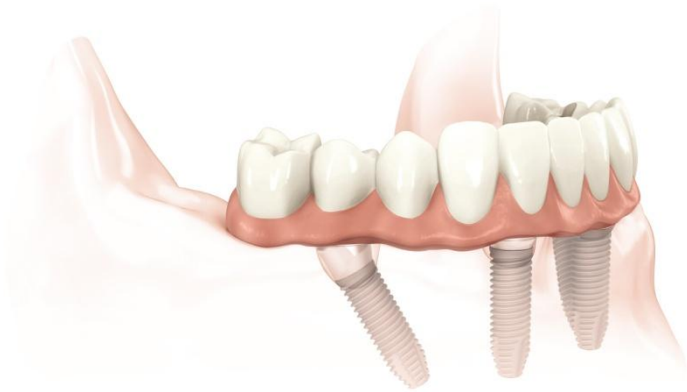
Removable full arch solutions offer many advantages compared to old-fashioned. Such as they

- Eliminate the need to use denture adhesives
- Sit securely in the mouth providing better chewing and speaking function
- Easily removed for cleaning and hygiene
- Avoid irritation and inflammation of gums; a common problem amongst denture patients

Fixed full-arch solutions on implants



A fixed bridge permanently secured on implants



**A fixed bridge permanently secured on implants,
using an All-on-4 solution**

A full arch solution is a durable dental prosthesis with natural looking replacement teeth.

It is permanently secured onto four or more dental implants. Dental implants, surgically placed in the jawbone, function like natural tooth roots

A fixed full arch solution offer several advantages

- Maintaining existing bone, preventing further bone loss
- Restoring chewing function and taste sensation
- Offering a solution which comes closest to natural teeth

What is the treatment procedure?

1. Examination

- ✓ Is implant treatment possible for you?
- ✓ What is the optimal solution based on your clinical situation and needs?

2. Cost calculation & Treatment planning

- ✓ Your doctor will prepare your treatment with costs in detail beforehand to ensure the best possible result.

3. Appointment for treatment

- ✓ Placing the implants under anesthesia.
- ✓ Wait for the implants to heal, while you could have a temporary prosthesis.
- ✓ Manufacturing of the final prosthesis.
- ✓ Individual checkup and maintenance scheme.

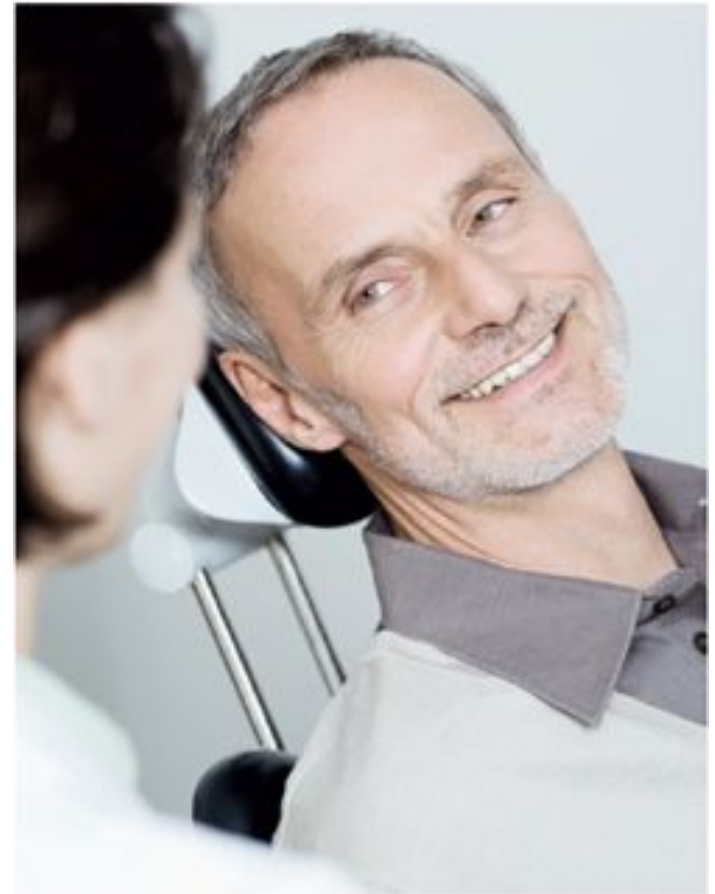

How much would it cost me?

- A good quality bridge and implant will cost u same or even cheaper. Still the cost of the implant will depend upon individual situation.
- However a dental implant treatment is an *investment in overall health, appearance and well being*, as it involves preserving the integrity of facial structures, as well as replacing missing teeth.
- Your new teeth can last a lifetime with proper care* – Just treat them like your natural teeth!

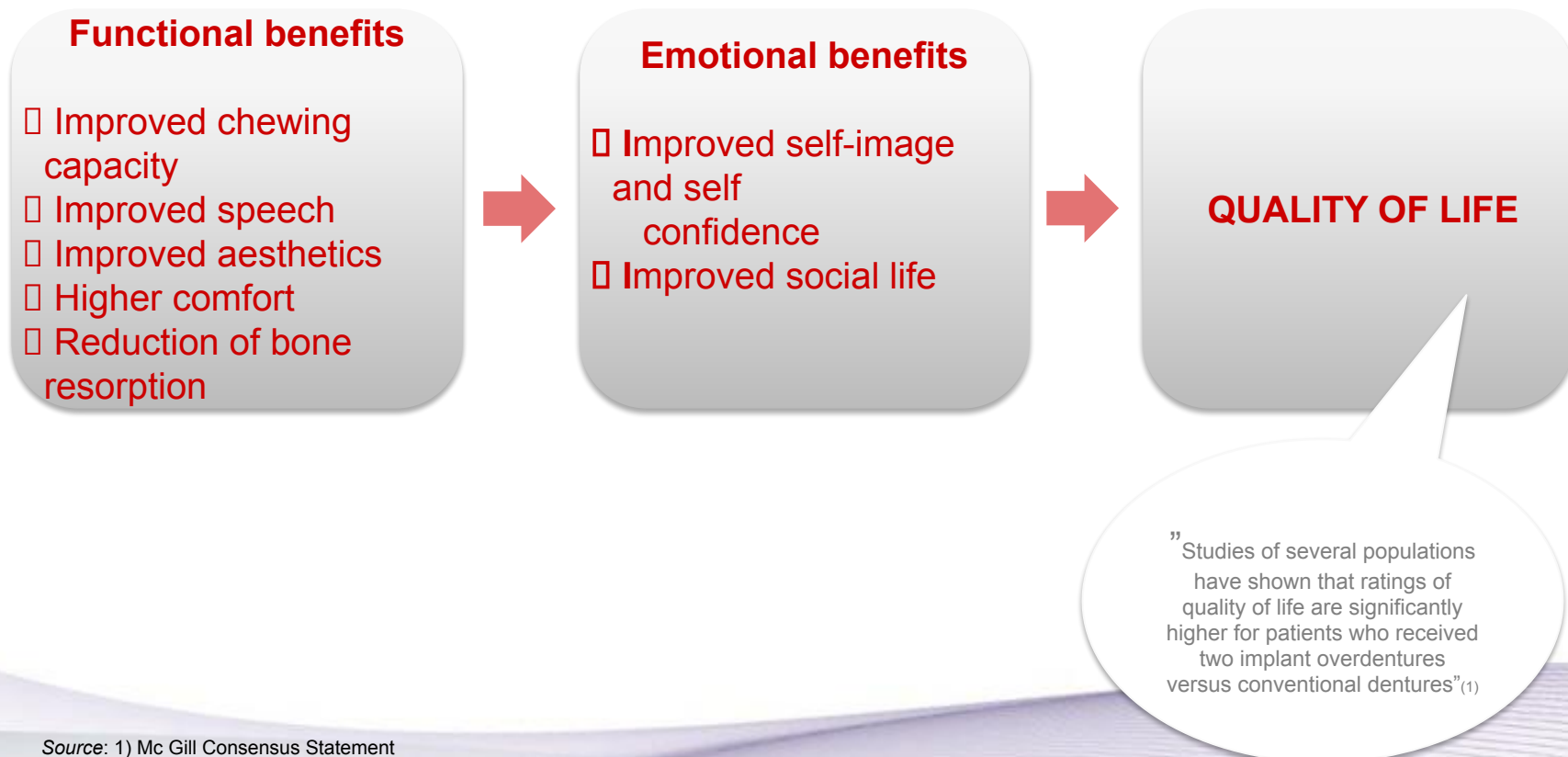

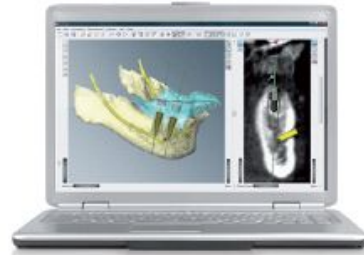
Dental implants are well documented to improve edentulous patients' Quality of Life.
